Steve Rance (District 9), Ron Parks campaign mgr for Sarah Corona (School Board) and Andrea DiMichael (Undeclared Judicial candidate).

Speaker Dennis Ross—Wanted to mention several points, the current state of elections, his affiliation with the previous T-Party, midterms and Charlie Kirk both of which touch on Socialism.



He got interested in Congress 6 years ago with DJ Trump presidency. He sees today's Congress as INEPT, and thanks DJT for exposing the deep state, fixing the border, re-instating our energy supremacy, re-gaining international respect, among others.

Below are notes from Steve Labate the Vice chair of the Republican Executive Committee (REC) who holds our Charter with the Republican Party of Florida (RPOF).

To put our place in perspective we are the Republican Club of Solivita, we are the bottom of the activists who see problems and report them to the REC who then sifts them and researches them to refer them to the RPOF which then adopts the problem as wide spread and seeks to find solutions to write bills that remedy by becoming law in Tallahassee. It all starts with US!!!

As I said Steve is the Vice Chair to the REC. His message is Success in Polk Co means no democrat should win any election. Their message is not for the people. They (Mamdani in NYC) dabble in sexual identity, they want to abolish private property. Don't take the bait of the free offers that car jacking is not a concern of drivers on the road, and that increased crime stats are not important to the average citizen. They are for the complete disregard of the citizen, again they offer free things, then being to limit those things, and reward those who preach their policies better than the average citizen forming elite groups (oligarchs if you will) that will determine the fate of those below them. We have a few elections coming up—Mayor of Lakeland, Commissioner in Polk Co, 2 School Board elections (which are over in August, the usual primary), Governorship, Senate and House of Rep. And Judgeships.

Commissioner of Polk co- one to track is Omar Arroyo
School board-- one to track is Sarah Corona
Gov- ones to track are Paul Renner and Byron Donalds
Senator—Track Ashley Moody
All our US Representatives
Judicial candidate—one to track is Andrea DiMichael (once she declares we will see less of her as this race by law is non-partisan. She however hails from a conservative background.)

We can bolster the vote by finding out who is like minded as we are and offering to give rides to others when early voting begins so that one trip will bring in 2 + votes. How does this help? An area like Winter Haven gets about 16% of the voters out at any one election. At the last election this tactic was implemented and the turn out was 51% of the voters. Thats an increase of 200+% AND our candidate won his election.

Note the Dems did this when they elected Pritzker in Illinois as their Governor. If it worked for them it can work for us. Get to know your neighbors!!!
